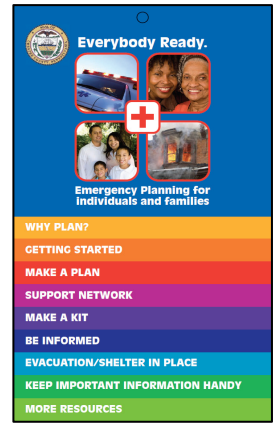

# A Group Evaluation of the *Everybody Ready* Personal Preparedness Handbook *(NEW FEBRUARY DATES)*



**WHO:** **Anyone who works with vulnerable populations** in Bucks, Montgomery, Chester, Delaware, or Philadelphia County. **Ideal participants:** *persons who have already attended the Everybody Ready training or are familiar with the handbook.*

**WHAT:** A one-time **roundtable discussion** to give feedback and recommendations to improve the *Everybody Ready* handbook and training. The *Everybody Ready* curriculum is used to prepare your staff, clients, and communities for public health emergencies like severe storms and disease outbreaks.
